

San Jose Chapter American Sewing Guild
Fabric Bargain Market Sale instructions for Consignees

Sewing Related Items only ! Only Fabric &/or Notions will be accepted.

Consignee needs to provide all of the following to sell items at the San Jose ASG Fabric Bargain Market sales.

1. **San Jose ASG Fabric Bargain Market Sale Agreement:** Read and complete.

2. Provide **Self-addressed and stamped #10 Business size envelope.**

3. **TAG EACH ITEM.** There are six blank tags on the form provided. The TAG must be used - No substitutes will be accepted.
 - **COMPLETE and ATTACH to EACH ITEM for SALE:** Use only TWO staples to attach to the top of the tag and in the selvage if possible. Small notions need to be placed in a clear zip-lock bag with the TAG attached to the OUTSIDE of the bag.
 - **PRICING:** Round prices up or down to the nearest \$1.00 dollar only. **NO mark down opportunities.** Printing on colored paper helps to recognizing your unsold items when picking up. (Avoid using Yellow or white)
 - **PICK UP YOUR UNSOLD ITEMS:** All unsold items must be picked up after the sale between 2:00 - 2:30 pm on Saturday May 18, 2024.

4. **INVENTORY LIST:** Please use **WHITE paper only.** Complete all information on the form. Number each item for sale on the inventory list. Number on inventory List must match number on Tag. **Make a copy of the inventory list for your records as this will not be returned.** Please note: Maximum of 20 items per page.

5. **DROP OFF TIMES FOR SALE:** The time for drop off is Friday May 17th, 7:00 - 7:30 pm. Items will be accepted for sale and placed on tables by the Consignment coordinator/team.

6. **PAYMENT FOR ITEMS SOLD:** ASGSJ will mail you a check in the envelope you provide with in 2-4 weeks of the sale. Or if you are a current ASGSJ Zelle user you may request using Zelle for your payment.

Any items that lose their tags during the sale may not be sold. After the sale there will be a designated table for you to claim any untagged items.

I agree that I must pick up my unsold items by 2:30 pm on May 18, 2024.

I will not hold the San Jose chapter of the American Sewing Guild responsible for any lost or damaged items.
